### *SWEDISH CAST-ONS AND SCANDINAVIAN KNITTING TECHNIQUES*

Saturday, March 19, 10 am – 1 pm \$60 plus \$3 for handout

Five one-needle cast-on methods from Sweden that can be adapted for one or two-color edges for sweaters, mittens, socks & hats. Continental & English methods of knitting, purling & weaving as a basis for the Scandinavian technique of working with two yarns in the left hand and Twined knitting (two yarns in the right hand.)

### *LATVIAN WRISTERS*

Saturday, March 19, 2 – 5 pm \$60 plus \$3 for handout

Some of the beautiful knitting methods of Latvia will be covered in this class and one of a pair of wristers will be knitted to learn the following techniques: a scalloped cuff, the herringbone braid, and many subtle and beautiful variations of the half-braid. A variety of traditional motifs are incorporated in the main part of the wrister. Other techniques covered include knitting with two yarns in the right hand, two yarns in the left hand, or a yarn in each hand, as well as setting up the knitting for color changes in the braids and weaving yarns to reduce float size, and reading from a chart.

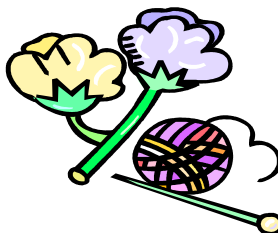

### *NORWEGIAN MITTENS*

Sunday, March 20, 10 am – 5 pm \$100 plus \$4 for handout

Students will learn Norwegian mitten construction by knitting a mitten in two colors, circularly, on double-pointed needles. Techniques to be covered include the striped, ribbed cuff, the Norwegian thumb gusset, seam stitches, different patterning for the front and palms, and the pointed tip shaping at the end of the mitten. Designing will be discussed as well as several options in thumb construction. A slide show of mittens in the Norwegian-American Vesterheim museum in Decorah, Iowa, will be featured as well.
