### **Sock Anatomy-Sunday, Feb 25, 1-5 pm -- \$60/student**

Want to knit socks but can't figure out the instructions? In this workshop you will make a mini-sock using double-pointed needles to learn all the skills to make a pair of basic socks. Call the store to enroll and find out about supplies/homework.

## **Karen Klemp's Workshops (cont'd)**

### **Crochet in Color – Saturday, Feb 3, 9 am-4 pm -- \$80/student**

Learn to crochet color patterns, like stripes, blocks, spikes, mosaic, intarsia, even entrelac; master the techniques of changing color, carrying unused colors along, making color and texture selections. Create swatches that will inspire you to make many different projects in the future. Call the store to enroll and find out about supplies/homework.

### **Chain Gang- Saturday, Feb 24, 9 am-noon -- \$55/student**

This workshop will demonstrate that the chain stitch has many uses beyond the dreaded beginning row of a project—chains for decorative stitch patterns, motifs, joinings, edgings, embellishments, etc. Learn how to begin projects without chaining. Call the store to enroll and find out about supplies/homework.

### **Woven Crochet-Saturday, Feb 24, 1-4pm -- \$55/student**

Learn three ways to weave in crochet, and find out how you can use certain “problem” yarns for weaving to achieve fabulous looks economically and with a minimum of effort. Call the store to enroll and find out about supplies/homework.

### **Crochet Edgings-Saturday, Mar 10, 9 am-noon -- \$55/student**

Learn to do many popular crochet trims like picot, crab stitch, shells, scallops, hanging blocks, loops, ruffles, popcorns, etc to give that professional look to your projects. Learn to work along the sides and to turn corners. NOTE: You must already know basic crochet to take this class. Call the store to enroll and to find out about supplies/homework.

### **Crochet flowers-Saturday, Mar 10, 1-4 pm -- \$55/student**

Learn to make a bouquet of different crocheted flowers that you can attach to hats, bags, turn into napkin rings, or pin on your coat. Learn how felted flowers are made, just spend a fun afternoon “playing” with crochet. Call the store to enroll and to find out about supplies/homework.

**Orphan Foundation Red Scarf Project – Claire Wudowsky**

Nearly 20,000 foster care teens “age out” of the foster care system each year. Once they reach 18, their state and foster families are no longer required to give them assistance. They are left to fend for themselves.

The Orphan Foundation provides opportunities for America’s foster youth to continue their education after high school, by raising funds directly, administering various states’ funding programs, mentoring, and care package deliveries. Less than 50% of foster children who age out of the system graduate from high school, and many end up on the street or in prison. The young people who do graduate from high school and go on to higher education are truly remarkable and deserving of support!

The Care Package Program is designed to show these youths attending colleges and trade schools that we care and support them in their efforts to better themselves. The Care Packages are delivered three times a year and they are chock-full of items designed to make life easier and more cheerful for these young people. Last year, for the first time, crocheted and knitted scarves were included in the Valentine’s Day packages – and they were a huge hit! This year the Orphan Foundation will be sending out 2500 Care Packages in February and they are looking for one scarf for each of these packages!

So...grab your hook or needles and crochet or knit a red scarf for the Orphan Foundation. If you need inspiration, there are red scarves hung up around the shop – and patterns for these are free with the purchase of a red yarn. You may drop off your finished scarf at the shop and we’ll deliver it to the Orphan Foundation.
